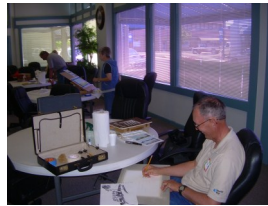

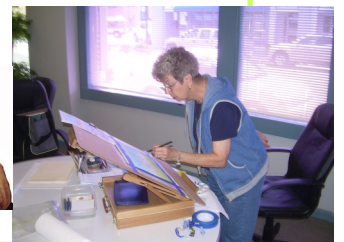

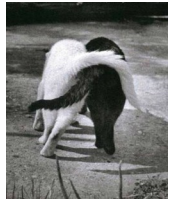
Caddo River Art Guild.

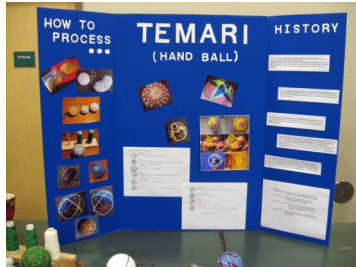


## June 2011 Guild meeting

Instruction and examples of the Japanese art of Temari were given by Delores Middleton. The door prize was a Temari ball won by Bette Baker.



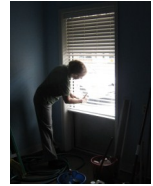

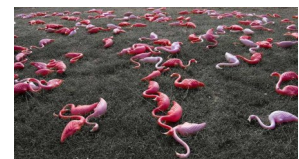


## Newsletter notes:
